We confirm herein, that batteries of our AIRBATT AIR-PB ranges are Valve Regulated Lead Acid (VRLA) > UN 2800 Batteries, wet, non-spillable < and are therefore exempt from the following Dangerous Goods (Hazardous Goods) Regulations. These regulations cover transport via Air, Water, Road and Rail.

International Maritime Dangerous Goods Code (IMDG Code) in their respective valid version. Requirements of Special Regulation# 238, items 1 + 2 are fulfilled.


>> Therefore these batteries are not subject to the regulations of the IMDG Code.
